

# THE SYMBOLISM OF THE ADVENT **WREATH**

- 1. The 4 candles represents the 4,000 years prior to Christ's coming and the 4 weeks of Advent.
- The 3 purple candles signify penance and the
- rose one joy.

  The unlighted candles represent the dark ages before Christ's coming.
- The lighted candles represent Christ, the Light of the World. Each week we light one more candle repre-
- senting the idea that the coming of Christ is closer.
- The circular form of the wreath symbolizes that God has no beginning and no end.
- The green of the boughs indicates hope just as
- the green of spring indicates new life.
  The word Advent means the "coming" of prom-
