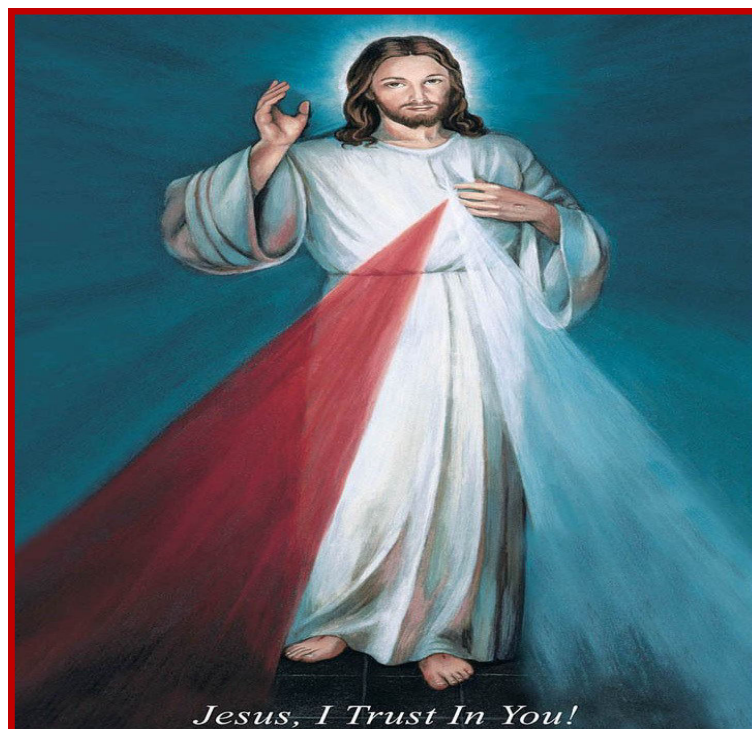

WHY IS JUNE THE MONTH FOR THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS?

The Sacred Heart of Jesus represents His love for humanity and brings us into Christ's interior life. This devotion inspires **us to remember how much Jesus loves us, while also growing our desire to love Him.** We **especially** need to love Him for so many who do not know about or outright reject His love.

"Behold the heart which has so loved men that it has spared nothing, even to exhausting and consuming itself, in order to testify its love; and in return, I receive from the greater part only ingratitude, by their irreverence and sacrilege, and by the coldness and contempt they have for me in this sacrament of love."
Jesus to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, 1675

The devotion grew when Jesus appeared to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque in the 17th century. In one of His messages He asked for a feast for His Sacred Heart:

"For this reason I ask that the first Friday after the octave of the feast of Corpus Christi be set aside as a special feast, to honor my heart by communicating on that day, and making reparation for the indignity it has received. And I promise that my heart will expand itself to pour out abundantly the influences of its love on all those who will give it this honor and get others to do the same".

The feast of Corpus Christi moves each year, meaning the Feast of the Sacred Heart is almost always in June. In 1856, Pope Pius IX expanded the Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus to the universal Church.

¿POR QUÉ JUNIO ES EL MES DEL SAGRADO CORAZÓN DE JESÚS?

El Sagrado Corazón de Jesús representa Su amor por la humanidad y nos introduce en la vida interior de Cristo. La devoción al Sagrado Corazón **nos inspira a recordar cuánto nos ama Jesús**, al tiempo que aumenta nuestro deseo de **amarlo especialmente**, amarlo por tantos que no saben acerca de Su amor o lo rechazan por completo.

"He aquí el corazón que tanto ha amado a los hombres que no ha escatimado nada, hasta agotarse y consumirse, para testimoniar su amor; y en cambio recibo de la mayor parte solamente ingratitude, por su irreverencia y sacrilegio, y por la frialdad y desprecio que me tienen en este sacramento de amor".
- Jesús a Santa Margarita María Alacoque, 1675

La devoción creció cuando Jesús se apareció a Santa Margarita María Alacoque en el siglo XVII. En uno de Sus mensajes pidió una fiesta para Su Sagrado Corazón:

"Por eso pido que el primer viernes después de la octava de la fiesta del Corpus Christi se dedique como fiesta especial, para honrar mi corazón comulgando en ese día, y reparando la indignidad que ha recibido. Y prometo que mi corazón se ensanchará para derramar abundantemente las influencias de su amor sobre todos los que le den este honor y hagan que otros hagan lo mismo".

La fiesta del Corpus Christi se mueve cada año, lo que significa que la Fiesta del Sagrado Corazón es casi siempre en junio. En 1856, el Papa Pío IX amplió la Fiesta del Sagrado Corazón de Jesús a la Iglesia universal.
